

This Global Intensive Experience will explore contemporary Brazilian society and politics, framing our large and diverse neighbor to the south in a global context and demonstrating the urgency of greater US-Brazil cooperation and understanding. Students will meet with representatives from the US State Department, Brazilian ministries, respected academics, indigenous and climate activists, and average Brasilienses to bring contemporary Brazil to life in an interactive way. Visits in and around the city, and to the nearby agricultural and ranching zones will demonstrate the profound challenges of inequality, sustainability, and economic development.
